33.8%	Infant child care- single parent	28.2%
64.5%	Two children- single parent	55.4%
69.8%	Married family with two children at the poverty line	60.0%

## Living in North Dakota

In North Dakota, single parents pay 33.8% of their income for center-based infant child care. Married parents of two children living at the poverty line pay 69.8% of their household income for center-based child care. The average price of center-based infant child care in North Dakota is more than the average annual tuition and fees at a public four-year college or university.
